

DRINKING DEEP

P R A Y E R

Corinthians 3:18 tells us that when we see God's glory, we are transformed to be like Him. Seeing God's glory is also where we begin in worshipping God. If we are going to worship God, we must first "see" Him. There are many ways He reveals Himself to us. Some of the main ways are through His Word, through His creation, and through His actions. When we pause to reflect on these things, worship becomes our natural response.

The Practice of the Week:

Read Psalm 136. In this Psalm, the writer is reflecting on who God is and His actions on behalf of His people. Then he responds with worship by saying after each verse, "His love endures forever."

Write your own psalm. Begin with a sentence about who God has been to you, or something he has done for you and then write, "His love endures forever."

For example, "God was my encourager when I walked through_____ . His love endures forever."

- Or - "I see God's beauty in creation around me. His love endures forever."

** The more specific you can be the better.*

**Try to fill one page. Don't worry about it rhyming or sounding poetic.*

**If you are musically inclined, try putting it to music.*
